Verint Prevails in Second Patent Litigation Case Against Nice in One Week

U.S. Federal Court Finds Non-infringement in Favor of Verint Systems

MELVILLE, N.Y., May 27, 2008 – Verint Systems Inc. today announced that the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Georgia entered a judgment of non-infringement in favor of Verint in a patent lawsuit brought by Nice Systems. In a bench trial, the honorable Judge Story found that Verint did not infringe the Nice patent (USPN 6,871,229) pertaining to Internet Protocol (IP) recording. This follows an announcement Verint made last week in which a Georgia jury declared valid and awarded the company over \$3.3 million in damages for Nice's infringement of Verint's speech analytics patent.

In total, there are four patent lawsuits between Verint and Nice, a series of litigations begun by Nice in 2004. Since the beginning of this year, three of the lawsuits have gone to trial with favorable outcomes for Verint in all three cases. Two of these lawsuits were filed by Nice, with Nice asserting six patents in total covering mostly older recording technology. Nice failed to carry its burden in both cases.

"As a company that respects intellectual property rights, we are gratified that the court determined that this claim had no merit. Our commitment to our customers and partners is to deliver innovative solutions with tangible business value. Part of that commitment includes protecting the intellectual property in those solutions, which provides confidence to our customers that our solutions are the safe choice for them," says Dan Bodner, CEO and President of Verint Systems.

Adds Peter Fante, Chief Legal Officer of Verint Systems, "The judge's non-infringement findings raise questions surrounding the value of Nice's patent portfolio and the credibility of their claims. Separately, the United States Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) has ordered re-examinations of a number of Nice patents, including patents at issue in suit, due to 'a substantial new question of patentability.'" Verint expects that the USPTO will narrow or invalidate a number of Nice patents through re-examination proceedings.

"This confirms what we have believed all along – that customers and partners who choose Verint are receiving market-leading solutions that help them meet critical business objectives using innovations that are proven and protected," notes Nancy Treaster, Senior Vice President and General Manager of Verint Witness Actionable Solutions. "With more than 400 patents and patent applications safeguarding our products, including our industry-leading workforce optimization solution, next-generation Impact 360[®], Verint is well positioned with a vast and secure intellectual property portfolio."

Verint is in the process of obtaining a trial date for its remaining case against Nice – an integrated screen-capture patent infringement case, where Verint is seeking more than \$30 million in damages and a permanent injunction against Nice. If Verint succeeds in obtaining treble damages in its integrated screen-capture case, Nice may be liable for more than \$100 million in damages.
